SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V Oban

SITREP #: 2 and final

SPILL NUMBER: 05119908201

LEDGER CODE: N/A

TIME/DATE OF INCIDENT: At 8:05 PM on March 23, 2005, the U.S. Coast Guard notified ADEC that the F/V Oban had run aground on the southwest corner of Duke Island at 6:22 PM on March 23, 2005. The F/V Oban is a 41' wood hull vessel.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:30 PM on March 29, 2005.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Marine diesel. Approximately 100 gallons of the fuel oil may have been released after storms battered the grounded vessel on March 25 & 26, 2005.

LOCATION: West side of Duke Island, which is approximately 10 miles south of Annette Island. (54 degrees 54.75 North Latitude/ 131 degrees 28.84 West Longitude).

CAUSE OF INCIDENT: The owner of the F/V Oban informed the U.S. Coast Guard that the electronic navigation system had failed.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Kevin Anderson, vessel owner.

RESPONSE ACTION: The PRP successfully off-loaded fifty-five (55) gallons of fuel from the grounded vessel on March 24, 2005 when seas were favorable for safe operations. High winds and large waves moved in to the area on March 25 and 26 preventing any further salvage/cleanup operations.

SOURCE CONTROL: The vessel owner initially plugged the fuel vents and secured the fuel line valves to prevent any oil to be released. Oil absorbent material was also placed in the engine room.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: There have been no reports of resources being impacted.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The owner met with the U.S. Coast Guard on March 28, 2005 and said that continued efforts will be made to salvage and remove debris and any recoverable oil from the wreckage on March 29, 2005, weather permitting.

WEATHER: Approx. 40° F, mostly cloudy, winds Northwest at 5-10 MPH.
