SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: DuRette Construction, Zarembo Isl. **SITREP #:** 3

SPILL NUMBER: 05119921401 **LEDGER CODE:** 14151360

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: Approximately 2:00 PM on August 2, 2005. The spill was reported to ADEC by DuRette Construction on August 4, 2005 at 10:00 AM.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:00 PM, August 15, 2005.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As the situation warrants.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: #2 Diesel Fuel, 2,200 gallons as estimated by DuRette Construction.

LOCATION: Along the road system of Roosevelt Harbor, Zarembo Island, 15 miles West-Southwest of Wrangell

CAUSE OF SPILL: A dump truck carrying a full fuel tank, flipped over and released diesel fuel from the top of the tank and onto the road and adjacent ground.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): DuRette Construction, Ward Cove, Alaska

RESPONSE ACTION: This spill was not reported to the State of Alaska until Thursday August 4, 2005. Since that time, DuRette Construction has hired Carson Dorn Inc., of Juneau, to manage the spill response for them. Carson Dorn has installed interceptor trenches lined with plastic down gradient from the spill site to intercept and collect the spilled fuel. 5 Hazwoper trained and certified personnel have been hired to monitor the sorbent pads placed into the interceptor trench and both the hard boom and sorbent boom placed into Roosevelt harbor. All saturated sorbent pads have been removed, wrung out, and either replaced into the interceptor trench or placed into storage containers for future use or disposal. Sorbent boom placed inside of hard boom in Roosevelt Harbor, have been monitored and replaced as they have become saturated. Saturated materials have also been stored for future disposal. Excavation of diesel saturated soils on and adjacent to the road system continues, with all removed materials being stockpiled for future treatment or removal. The contractor estimates that approximately 96% of the diesel contamination has been collected and removed. Sampling is almost complete at all excavation sites, with samples being submitted to a lab for analysis. Over the last three or four days, no sheen has been reported outside of the boomed area in Roosevelt Harbor and very little sheening has been observed inside the boom.

SOURCE CONTROL: The dump truck and the fuel tank it was carrying have been turned upright and transported from the site.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: There have been no reports of oiled wildlife. Resources affected have yet to be assessed.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Oil contaminated soils are being stored in a segregated lined storage site at an existing contaminated soils site in Wrangell. Approximately 500-600 cubic yards of contaminated soils have been removed so far. DEC will require a written plan for the ultimate treatment and disposal of the contaminated soils along with all other contaminated materials from this spill, once cleanup activities are completed. Collection and containment systems will be monitored closely later this week when rains are anticipated and materials could be flushed down the site and into the waters of Roosevelt harbor.

USCG, USFS, ADEC, and ADF&G continue to monitor the situation.

WEATHER: Currently Low 60's F, winds to 10-15 mph. Forecast: Overcast, with the high potential for rains late in the week.
