### Seafood Advisory

#### Recommended Crab Fishery Oil Sampling Procedure

If oil is encountered on gear or product:

- Take a photograph of the oil in the location found (if possible).
- Document the vessel location and time the oil or tarball was found.
- Sample the oil by scraping a portion free from the gear or product with a tongue depressor, toothpick or similar item that is clean and free of dirt, grease or other contamination. The sample size required is not large. Oil or tar approximately ½ the size of a fingernail is sufficient.
- Place the entire toothpick or tongue depressor into clean aluminum foil and fold all edges.

After returning to port, contact the Environmental Unit in the Incident Command Center in Dutch Harbor at the number listed below. A representative of the Incident Command will come to the vessel or otherwise meet the crew to collect the sample, record the sample location information, sample ID and name of vessel and sampler in the appropriate forms for transmittal to a laboratory for potential analysis.
