**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** DuRette Construction, Zarembo Isl.      **SITREP #:** 4 and Final

**SPILL NUMBER:** 05119921401                                      **LEDGER CODE:** 14151360

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** Approximately 2:00 PM on August 2, 2005. The spill was reported to ADEC by DuRette Construction on August 4, 2005 at 10:00 AM.

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** 11: 00AM., September 11, 2006

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** This is the final SITREP

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** #2 Diesel Fuel, 2,200 gallons as estimated by DuRette Construction.

**LOCATION:** Along the road system of Roosevelt Harbor, Zarembo Island, 15 miles West-Southwest of Wrangell

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** A dump truck carrying a full fuel tank flipped over and released diesel fuel from the top of the tank and onto the road and adjacent ground.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** DuRette Construction, Ward Cove, Alaska

**RESPONSE ACTION:** Upon completing the emergency oil spill response actions by utilizing Carson Dorn Inc., of Juneau and TY-MATT, Inc. of Ketchikan, the contaminated material was stockpiled on a bermed liner and covered. The spill case was then transferred to the Department's Contaminated Sites (CS) program.

CS worked with the responsible party and the United States Forest Service concerning the necessary corrective treatment and disposal actions. The oil contaminated material has been properly treated and therefore has met the Department's alternative cleanup levels. The treated material has been land spread, fertilized, and seeded with grass.

The ADEC oil spill response container in Wrangell was accessed by DuRette Construction soon after discovering the oil spill. DuRette Construction has cleaned and returned all equipment used and has replaced all absorbent material.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** There have been no reports of oiled wildlife. Resources affected initially were soil and gravel in the immediate area of the release, in addition to the marine waters in Roosevelt Harbor
