





Safety Reminders

For ICP Personnel

Please remember the following:

1. Exercise care when navigating the ICP; there are lots of power cords and comm. cables on the floor. Most are secured, but there is still a trip potential.
2. Exits are at the left rear of the room near the JIC table. Turn right when leaving the Command Post and proceed down the stairs to the street (6th Ave). Muster location is the east parking lot.

For On Scene Personnel

1. Exercise care when operating on the Cougar.
2. Utilize all safety precautions, especially safety lines when working on deck, outside, on in confined spaces.
3. Monitor the atmosphere in spaces periodically, and prior to making entry or working within.
4. Observe the communications and emergency action protocols as presented in daily briefings.
5. Use the buddy system, watch out for each other.
