SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V *Kupreanof* Grounding

SITREP #: 2

SPILL NUMBER: 10269904501

LEDGER CODE: Not Requested

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The F/V *Kupreanof*, a 58-foot wooden hull vessel, grounded off of Chignik Lagoon at 10:58 AM on February 14, 2010. The grounding was reported to ADEC at 7:30 PM on February 14, 2010.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:30 PM on February 19, 2010

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As the situation warrants

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: This is a potential spill. The vessel owner and crew reported to US Coast Guard (USCG) that the vessel had approximately 300 gallons of diesel fuel, and 300 gallons of oily lube water on board. The vessel owner reported no oil was released to the environment, but bilge oil may have leaked when the vessel's hull became submerged.

LOCATION: Chignik Lagoon is located on the south shore of the Alaska Peninsula, approximately 450 miles southwest of Anchorage, Alaska.

CAUSE OF SPILL: The vessel owner reported that the F/V *Kupreanof* suffered ice damage to the forward section of the hull. The incident is being investigated by the USCG Sector Anchorage office.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): D & S Fisheries, LLC.

RESPONSE ACTION: On February 18, 2010, a marine surveyor with the International Marine Underwriters (IMU) inspected the vessel. On February 19, 2010, the marine surveyor reported to ADEC that the F/V *Kupreanof* is a total structural loss. The PRP is in the process of completing additional repairs on the vessel's port-side bottom section to maintain water seal integrity; and is acquiring additional drums to pump the remaining fuel and oily water from the vessel.

SOURCE CONTROL: The vessel's hull was temporarily repaired and all fuel vents to the vessel have been closed.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: There have been no reports of impacts to wildlife or the shoreline.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: US Coast Guard (USCG) Sector Anchorage and ADEC have requested that the PRP submit a transit and salvage plan for approval. In addition, USCG and ADEC requested that the PRP submit a third party marine survey report of the vessel's hull condition, with a statement that the vessel is deemed seaworthy for any intended transit. The PRP will continue to remove remaining fuel and oily water from the vessel.

WEATHER: Temperature 30°F, mostly cloudy with scattered snow showers, winds 14 mph from Southwest. Tonight lows in 20s, cloudy with isolated snow showers, winds variable at 10 mph.


